Chief Rabbi; Davies. Personal Approach as a spiritual leader.

David is threatened by Goliath; not only a King but a religious poet.

Israel is the custodian of a religious tradition; a threat to Israel is a threat to this - which has kept the Jews alive for centuries in the hope of a restoration to Zion. The British have played a decisive part in this. We ask for a hearing by the British conscience. Bitterness now felt. Phone call from Jerusalem this morning. Also 500,000 British Jews. Apprehensions over rift. David was not faultless. We are aware of his faults, but consider also his contributions to all human experience. Himself (C.R.) with family a refugee from Nazi Germany. Moral concerns and understanding between peoples. Danger of alienation. Peace.

Contribution by Britain. The whole of Israel a remnant of a decimated nation. We feel ourselves isolated and friendless. Israel told all along; rely on guarantees. But can we rely on world public opinion? Israel has found that she cannot rely on world opinion. If she had not experienced lack of sympathy, Israel would not be so insular or intransigent.
