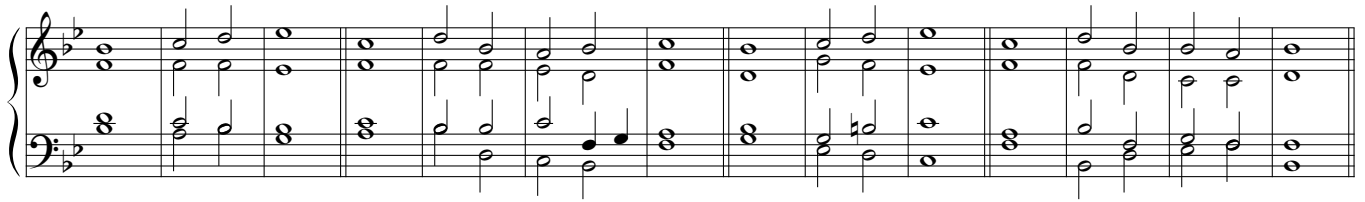


# PSALM 126
