Instructions for signing your codicil

1. Obtain two witnesses. They must not be beneficiaries under your Will or Codicil, their wives or husbands, or an executor. You must all three be present when the codicil is signed and witnessed.
2. Sign your name in ink where indicated at the end of the Codicil. Use your normal signature.
3. The Witnesses must sign where shown and add clearly their full names, addresses and preferably their occupations.
4. Do not attach anything to your Codicil! For example, do not attach paper clips or pins as this may cause difficulties in proving your Will with the Probate Registry on your death.
5. It is vital that all formalities are properly observed otherwise your Codicil may be invalid.
