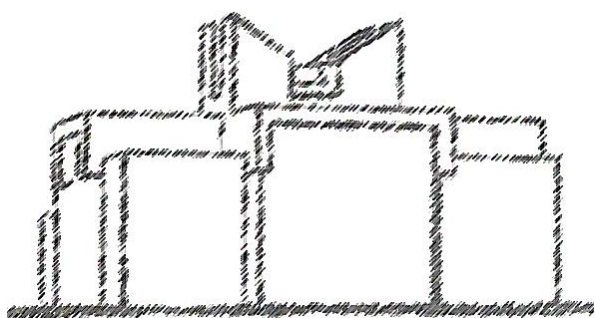

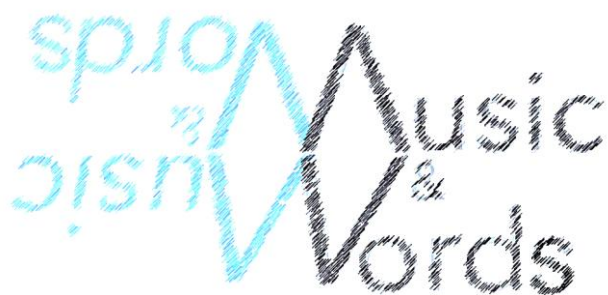

## **The Chapel at Churchill**

The Chapel at Churchill is an inclusive and welcoming space. All services are free and open to everyone regardless of creed or college membership. Tea and cakes are served before services at which the choir sings, and there is often sufficient to finish off after the service. When the choir are not present, there is a said evening service at 5.15pm in termtime so that people can go on to Music and Words at Murray Edwards.

Members of Churchill can access the chapel for quiet contemplation or prayer using the Salto facility on their university card or may borrow a fob from the Porters. There are easy chairs and a bookshelf on diverse religions and beliefs. The chapel can also be booked for music practice and other agreed activities via the chapel website, where there is also an archive of sermons.

## **Inter Alios Choir**

The Inter Alios choir perform every Sunday of term, alternating between an Anglican Evensong and a unique 'Music & Words' event which combines choral music, poetry and a short address. 'Inter Alios' translates as 'among others' and speaks to the collective spirit of the choir: inter-faith, inter-collegiate, and international.

The choir welcomes singers with a wide range of experience. Our members are mostly un-auditioned, but we have an auditioned Chamber Choir including Choral Scholars at our core. Choral Scholars take on a leadership role within the choir and are supported with vocal lessons.
